Architecture at sea was how the award-winning Dubois came to view his work. Featuring a raked bow which contributes to her streamlined appearance and improved performance, MOSAIQUE was proportioned on the “golden ratio” which has underscored so much great naval architecture over the centuries. The full-displacement hull is painted a striking Marlin Blue, which successfully contrasts with the white superstructure and boot top.

Remarkably spacious and well laid-out exterior decks

MOSAIQUE's wide beam ensures she has excellent interior and outside deck space for her size. Crowning the yacht is a spacious sundeck with a whirlpool surrounded by sunpads forward, a bar, and two tables for informal meals amidships and a gym area aft. The large upper deck features an oval teak table, shaded by the sun deck above, that can seat up to 16 guests. Further aft there is a relaxation area with teak deck furniture and sun beds. The aft main deck has stairs leading down to a fixed boarding and bathing platform.

Originally designed to reflect the ambience of a traditional country house, MOSAIQUE retains a sense of intimacy and ease throughout. Her thoughtful layout, beautiful boiserie and cabinetry were preserved during the 2022 refit but restyled with a Hampton Beach vibe. Her graceful décor in neutral tones, cream and white, showcases her well-proportioned space and large windows. The main salon and dining area for 12 are separated by an Art Deco bar while the more intimate bridge deck salon reflects a more nautical style with accents of navy and light blue.

Chic with a serene and positive atmosphere

The sumptuous full-beam master suite and VIP stateroom are forward on the main deck. Four other staterooms - another VIP, two doubles and a twin - are amidship on the lower deck opening off the central staircase. All staterooms have large bathrooms splendidly decorated in exotic onyx or marble with the hand basins carved out of the stone. In all, MOSAIQUE sleeps twelve guests and accommodates twelve crew in six cabins. For additional comfort at anchor MOSAIQUE is equipped with zero speed stabilization.
